CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The competition is open to anyone living in Australia or New Zealand who is aged 17 or under at 30/11/2008. Clearly print your name and age at the end of your entry, as well as on this form.
2. There is no entry fee. There is a limit of one entry per person. Entries will not be returned.
3. The report of the interview may be between 1500 and 3000 words in length and must be your own original work.
4. The report should begin with a summary of the musician's achievements and a rationale for choosing her/him to interview. Most of the report should be in the form of a summary of the musician's responses to the interview questions, along with your analysis of these, and should include some direct quotations from the musician. The report should conclude with a statement of what you learned from the exercise, and anything else you think worth including. A list of the questions asked should be included as an appendix. An edited transcript of the interview may also be included as an appendix.
5. Contact details for the musicians interviewed must be included, to allow them to check the report to ensure that their ideas have been reported accurately. The musician need not be a famous person, nor necessarily an adult, but must be a practising musician, either full-time or part-time, as work or a hobby.
6. Prizes of **\$150** will be awarded to the winning entries in each section of the award. Other prizes may be awarded to Highly Commended entries. If the number and quality of entries warrant it, there will be separate 'junior' (age 12 and under) and 'senior' (age 13 to 17) awards. The judging panel's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
7. Entries for this year's award must be *posted by 26 November 2008*. Please send a printed copy plus an electronic copy in Microsoft Word burned onto a CD.
8. Winners will be notified by mail or email. Results and the best entries will be published in *TalentEd* and on the *TalentEd* web site: <http://scs.une.edu.au/TalentEd/>.
